I am also writing to say that I was dismayed last night at the meeting held by Sandoval County at the Zocalo and facilitated by Cliff Spirock to hear from the BLM that Sandoval County is using the Privacy Act and requesting info that Sandoval County sends to the BLM be marked confidential. I am waiting for your words on that in the hopes that this information is a mis-communication of some kind.

As I stated to Tom Gow last night at that meeting,

1. This seems to fly in the face of Open Government.
2. This seems to fly in the face of the Open Records Act.
3. This seems that it would be counter to running a Democracy where the government which is for and by the people, and I will add, as well as paid for by the people.

I am patiently waiting for a response to my letter below, as well as the Open Records responses, as well as now, I would also like to understand under what conditions, and under what specific statutes, you would designate Sandoval County info sent to the BLM as confidential.
